The French Police is mourning following the killing of two police officers Jean Baptist Salvaing Jessica Schneider and his companion has Magnanville. A ceremony of very moving and dignified tribute was held today at the police prefecture of Paris, chaired by the President of the Republic and Holland Francois Bernard Cazeneuve the Minister of Interior.-----

According to "Le Monde" Monday, June 13 evening, Jean-Baptiste Salvaing, 42, and his girlfriend Jessica Schneider, 36, were brutally killed by Larossi Abballa while they were in their house, alley Partridge, to Magnanville, Yvelines. They had set a three year old son they leave behind. The couple was unanimously appreciated by those around them.

The man spent most of his career with the police in the Yvelines: urban security brigade (BSU) of Mantes-la-Jolie and the Anti-Crime Brigade (BAC) county. At his death, he worked as deputy chief of criminal investigation units of the police Mureaux. He had a very good reputation among his colleagues. Once they have learned to the drama, many of them felt the need to come together to the police.

**JESSICA SCHNEIDER AGED 36 YEARS WAS ASSISTANT AT POLICE STATION OF MANTES LA JOLIE-----**

According to "Le Monde"<sup>[?]</sup>, Jessica Schneider was administrative assistant in Mantes-la-Jolie police station. It is described as "popular" and a "proximity" by Julien Le Cam, departmental secretary in the Yvelines. The couple lived in Magnanville for five years and was invested in the town. "We were often in relation to on associative and sporting life. Especially with it, "says Michel Lebouc, various left mayor of the city. Ms. Schneider also was working in his son's school. A psychological unit was set up in the town of 6000 inhabitants. The only survivor of the massacre is the little boy the couple, aged 3 years. Jean-Baptiste Salvaing also leaves behind another child from a previous marriage.-----

**CHILD' S COUPLE MURDERED IS IN SHOCK AND HAD A STRONG TRAUMA-----**

According to Metro News, the child was "shocked but unharmed." He was three, he was found by the police after a man claiming to Daech killed with knives his parents, a police commander and his wife Monday in Magnanville (Yvelines). The murder of the police officer and his wife leaves two orphans. One, aged 11, born of a previous marriage, was not present the night of the tragedy. The other, the younger, was there. For both, a question remains: they are alive, yes. But how will they cope? Overcoming such a traumatic experience?
